

Mission Opportunity in Guatemala

Crabtree Valley Baptist Church has a long history of supporting missions. On Oct 1-9, Cheryl and Brian Walker are going on a mission trip with First Baptist Wilmington to the remote city of Chimaltenango in central Guatemala. In a week, 4 teams of 10 people will complete 16 houses. One criteria for receiving a house is that the family's current living space must not have real walls or any type of floor. The local community pastor chooses families who he considers morally deserving and gives these names to the missionary in Chimaltenango who picks work sites and assigns teams. The translator tells the families that these volunteers are there to help them, but they are there primarily as Christians following God's command to share His love - that's the fun part. The volunteers will also spend time playing with the children and getting to know the families. Our CVBC children will be making gifts to send to the children, and we will also take a lot of supplies like beads, ribbon, soccer balls, shoes, and school supplies.

Our Deacons have approved a love offering for this ministry. We will receive this offering on Sunday Morning, September 11, during the worship hour. Any monies collected in the love offering will be used to buy supplies and Polaroid film so the Walkers can take pictures of the children and give them to them as presents. Contributions can be made to CVBC and designated Guatemala Love Offering. You are encouraged to be generous in this love offering and to give it above and beyond your regular contribution. Thank you for wanting to share God's love to the world.
