We all need breaks in life from the mundane, the routine, the aggravation, the frustrations and even the day to day grind. His strategy for coping with life's pressures was to come apart from the pressures and stresses before you fall apart.

Last May, before summer began, I urged you to get away from your routine responsibilities and enjoy some quiet time of physical and spiritual renewal.
