There is a line in the famous story, "a Christmas Carol" from the pen of Charles Dickens and it comes from the heart of transformed Mr.

Scrooge: "I will honor Christmas in my heart, and try to keep it all the year. I will live in the Past, the Present, and the Future. The Spirits of all Three shall strive within me. I will not shut out the lessons that they teach!"

Being a Christian means that we have come to grips with our past personal sins, acknowledged them, confessed them, repented of them and accepted the fact that Jesus took upon himself the punishment that we deserve and died on the cross, rose again and offers to us forgiveness, grace, mercy, peace and eternal life. Being a Christian means that in the present we faithfully serve Christ and use the talents that he has given us to do so. Being a Christian means that we may not know what the future holds but we know who holds the future. Our future is secure in His hands and we have peace in our hearts because He is preparing a place for us in eternity with Him. Being a Christian means that we will not shut out the lessons that Christ taught us in word and deed. We honor him because he is Lord of Lord, King of Kings, our redeemer and Savior. Our Christmas is truly MERRY because we have an inheritance and a peace that cannot be taken from us.
