Sarah and I look forward to each year.

Now, most of us realize how much choir members practice before this musical is presented. We rehearse every week to learn rhythms, notes and words. This is Ernie's opportunity to push us a little further each year with increasingly complex pieces of music. What you may not know is that Ernie starts thinking about the next musical as soon as the current one is over. You see, Ernie doesn't just pull out a book with that year's musical presented in a neat little package. He handpicks the selections we sing from a variety of places and combines them into a presentation that is enjoyable and meaningful. He puts together books for us as well books for the orchestra (they don't need the words). Each participant is given a CD to listen to so that rhythms and vocal patterns become almost second nature. Careful thought is given to presentation, cohesiveness and message. Soloists are chosen and they get to take the time to memorize their solos. The sound system is tweaked and any lighting issues are addressed. Signage is prepared and postcard invitations are designed. Arrangements are made for members to secure tuxes and ladies' apparel is selected. Ernie is responsible for seeing that all the details are covered. He does this knowing that this whole event could be a train wreck or wonderful experience for all.

It's easy for us to sit back and enjoy the Christmas musical each year. It's an important part of the Holidays for our church. But we often forget all the work that goes into a presentation like this. And it's easy to forget that there is a wonderful message given to us through the musical. Yes, Ernie works very hard all year to pull this thing together. He certainly doesn't have to work so hard – new cantatas are published every year that he could just purchase and use. But he wants to present something that is beautiful as well as challenging for us. He wants the message to be offered in a way that might be different. As a church, we are blessed to have Ernie as a part of our family. He gives 110% to weekly services as well as special events.
