This Sunday Feb 9: John 15:9-17 and 1 Corinthians 12:31-13:13. Next Sunday Feb 16: 1 Corinthians 3:1-9



At about this time last year, I had the privilege of preaching in two very different Baptist congregations. One church met in a large fellowship hall. The worshipers sat on folding chairs and wore blue jeans. The lyrics were projected on a big screen while a band played contemporary songs with their guitars, a keyboard, and drums. The other church was

traditional and formal. Most of the women wore dresses and the worshipers sat on pews, singing along with a traditional choir and using a hymnal. It was a great experience to see the diverse ways in which NC Baptists worship. In both cases, the reason I was invited to preach was because the congregations were participating in Martha Stearns Marshall Month of Preaching.

Martha Stearns Marshall was an 18th century Separate Baptist – and a preacher! In 1810, Virginia Baptist historian Robert Semple wrote: "...without the shadow of a usurped authority over the other sex, Mrs. Marshall, being a lady of good sense, singular piety, and surprising elocution, has, in countless instances melted a whole concourse into tears by her prayers and exhortations!"

Since 2007, Baptist Women in Ministry (BWIM) has invited Baptist churches to participate in Martha Stearns Marshall Month of Preaching by having a woman preach during the month of February. According the BWIM, "the annual event has been a deeply significant source of joy and discovery for many women and churches." As a church that already has a female preacher, Crabtree is using this as an opportunity to stand with and support Baptists who are still hoping for and dreaming of the day that their church will allow women to preach.

Caitlin Estes will be the Martha Stearns Marshall preacher at Crabtree Church on Sunday, February 16. Caitlin recently graduated from Campbell Divinity School with an M. Div. degree. She has a desire to see young people empowered to think beyond what was culturally acceptable. During a research project funded through the Fund for Theological Education in 2011, Caitlin began looking into the interaction between faith and culture in Western society. Her research took her across Europe and back to the States, where she continued the conversation with individuals, articles, and more. This led her to develop "More than Millennial" (www.morethanmillennial.com), where she is founder and creative director. I look forward to hearing Caitlin preach on the 16th and to her meeting the fellowship of believers at Crabtree Church. Yours in Christ. Pastor Nola
