

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ, This is an excerpt from the letter I read to the congregation at the end of the service on Sunday followed by an update since Sunday.

SUNDAY'S LETTER: I have recently made a very difficult decision. It is with great heartache that I have submitted my notice of resignation to the diaconate. My last Sunday will be February 22. Until then, I will be here and will be fully present with you. Over the next month, I hope to give and receive lots of warm hugs and sweet blessings. Please know that each of you will continue to hold a special place in my heart.

Where am I going? Well, thankfully, I am not being called to go to Nineveh, as Jonah was! But the Spirit has been stirring within me, prompting me to make a change. I can say that I am still called to serve in ministry, you all have played an important part in affirming that for me. Thank you!

As I think back on the first sermon I preached here, I recall saying something about how the head of the church is not the pastor or the deacons or any committee. The head of the church always has been and always will be the Lord Jesus Christ. Whether I am here or not, Christ will continue being the head of the church.

Christ will lead you. Follow Him.

I am thankful that by the power of the Holy Spirit we will continue to be bonded with each other. I am honored and blessed to be eternally united with such a caring, loving, and compassionate group of God's people who are the fellowship of believers at Crabtree Valley Baptist Church. I love and care about each one of you. I will continue to love and care about each of you.

UPDATE SINCE SUNDAY: Since Sunday several of you have come to me, expressing concern about my well-being. Thank you for your concern! Allow me to expand on what I said earlier.

In the time that I have served as pastor, I have felt the call to pastor both in the traditional church/parish setting and in nontraditional context/ways. Over the past few months, I have been feeling a strong pull to put my time and energy into the non-traditional areas of ministries. I cannot do that and continue to give the people of CVBC (whom I love) the time and attention that you deserve from your pastor. Starting in March, I will be serving as a community pastor leading a coffeehouse Bible study. This is a space where folks who have never studied the Bible or who are not comfortable in a church setting can feel safe. In addition, I will be serving as a pulpit supply pastor. I also plan to get back to writing my book. During this time, I will be discerning the next step – will I continue serving as a pastor in nontraditional ways and spaces, seek a part-time parish pastor position, or seek a full-time parish pastor position? I trust that God will lead me in the right direction, and I trust that God will send the right person to be the next pastor of Crabtree Valley Baptist Church.
