*To use the Youth House for a Refugee Ministry in partnership with the Governmental Agency, CBF, RBA, and other churches.

*To receive contributions, from interested individuals and grants to financially support the Refugee Ministry.

*To establish a <u>Welcome House Bank Account</u> separate from our regular Church Banking account to receive donations for the Refugee Ministry.

*To affirm Peninah Brown, Jean Glosson & Gene Sherwood as CVBC Representatives on the CBV Hospitality Committee

The Mosiac Church of Clayton has volunteered to do yard work and landscaping on the Welcome House. Baptist Men have offered to paint the inside of the house and grants of \$4,500 have been made available by CBF of North Carolina and the Raleigh Baptist Association.
