Wednesday, March 5 is the first day of Lent this year. Lent is marked by a time of prayer and preparation to celebrate Easter. It is a time for introspection, selfexamination, and repentance. Some Christians "give something up" for Lent. Traditionally, rich foods like red meat and chocolate might be given up. Today, Christians might also give up something like

social media or watching television. Others prefer to "add something" during Lent – more time spent in prayer, in serving the poor, or reading the Bible, for example. The purpose of these Lenten disciplines is not for them to be like a New Year's Resolution or for us to brag about our accomplishments. "Whenever you pray, go into your room and shut the door and pray to your Father who is in secret." (Matthew 6:6) The goal, rather, is to draw nearer to God.

This Lenten season we'll be looking at some vices to "give up," not just during Lent but for the long-haul of our journey as followers of Christ.
