Two important Sundays are coming up in the life of Crabtree Valley Baptist Church. This Sunday, 9/7, Kevin will be baptized. Next Sunday, 9/14, Robert will be ordained and installed as a deacon. I have been

thinking a lot about the significance of each of these events. Both Kevin and Robert are making sacred commitments to Jesus Christ and to the church. And the church is also making a commitment, a covenant, with these two individuals – promising to pray for them and support them.

This is the second year that I have been serving as pastor during a deacon election. Last year, two new deacons were ordained and installed, and a third (already ordained) deacon was installed. This year, only one person nominated said "yes" to serving as deacon. All of the others respectfully declined. So, at the August business meeting, some decisions had to be made. The congregation approved the suspending of two bylaws for the period of one year. This allows for there to be less than eight deacons, and it allows for two members of the same household to serve on the diaconate. The two household members serving this year are not husband and wife, but an adult son and his mother. Again, this suspension is only in effect for one year.

Starting this month, the new diaconate will consist of seven men and women. While it would have been nice to have filled all of the positions, I feel confident that these seven deacons are dedicated to serving the church. Over the course of the last year, I have seen the way the diaconate has functioned so well as a team. There is no question in my mind that each deacon, called by God and ordained by the congregation, has a desire to fulfill the will of God and to work for the benefit of the congregation. I am thankful for their wisdom, guidance, and leadership.

Many of you have gone up to a military veteran and thanked them for their service. I wonder, have any of you gone up to a deacon and thanked them for their service to the church? If you haven't done that recently, I would encourage you to do so in the near future. Thank these servant leaders and lift them up in your prayers.
