#### THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK

Mark your calendar for Wednesday night, April 26. Your presence is needed at CVBC at 6:30pm when Marc Wyatt and his invited guests will be with us to explain what is involved in a Refugee Ministry.

At our February Business Conference the idea of renovating and renting the youth house was brought up for discussion. During that session, the idea of a refugee ministry was mentioned. Following that meeting, George Shore, Ben Best, Walt Switzer and I met with Marc Wyatt, Bill Baxley and others to look at our Youth House and to discuss a partnership with Baptist Men, Habitat for Humanity and sister churches. Ideas were shared and we joined in prayer for God's leadership.

At our March Business Meeting, we shared the results of our conversation with the group that met in the Youth House. At that time, we asked the church body if they would like for us to continue the information process. Approval was granted.

Marc Wyatt leads the Refugee Ministry in the Triangle area. He has agreed to be with us on Wednesday evening, April 26, at 6:30pm to share the need and impact of this ministry in our area. After the presentation, there will be time for questions. It will be up to the CVBC Family to decide if we sense that it is the Will of God to move forward with a Refugee Ministry. Your presence at this meeting is critical to this decision. We need as many members as possible to get the facts and ask the appropriate questions.

The roof on the Youth House has been replaced. Inside repairs and painting have been put on hold until we have further discussions with possible partners in this ministry. Please join us in prayer as we seek God's direction about entering into a Refugee Ministry.
