

Thought for the Week

July 12, is a date to mark on your calendar. We are calling the church together for a "Town Hall" meeting at 6:30pm to present information about a Refugee Ministry which would involve the use of our Youth House.

The Group of Seven that visited the Refugee Ministry of Hope Valley Baptist Church in Durham on May 9, met on June 23, with Marc and Kim Wyatt, Field Missionaries in the Triangle and with Roger Nix, Director of Missions of the Raleigh Baptist Association.

The purpose of the meeting was to specifically gain understanding on how a Refugee Ministry works. We learned that the primary and most critical part of the ministry is housing. The fact that CVBC has a house answers the most critical need. We learned that being involved in a Refugee Ministry does not have to be a burden financially or otherwise to our church. There are other organizations (CBF, RBA, Baptist Men, etc) and churches in the area with members who are eager to partner with us in this endeavor.

The Refugee Ministry works in partnership with the Governmental Agency in the Triangle that receives immigrants into our area, helps them find a temporary home, pays their rent and helps them find a job and move on to self-support. A Hospitality Committee coordinated by Kim & Marc Wyatt and composed of members of other churches and representatives of CVBC will assist the family with personal needs, initial food supplies, furnishing the host home, etc. CVBC will be responsible for maintenance on the house and providing a spiritual ministry to the family.

This information and more will be part of our open discussion on July 12. You are urged to make this meeting a priority in your schedule and to pray daily for a clear understanding of God's Will for CVBC in this matter.
