THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK

If there has ever been a doubt in your mind as to whether Jesus Christ is the Son of God, the Savior of the world I urge to you to consider the words from Dyson Hague, a Canadian Theologian:

"Centuries before Christ was born, His birth and career, His sufferings and glory, were all described in outline and detail in the Old Testament. Christ is the only person ever born into this world whose ancestry, birth-time, forerunner, birth-place, birth manner, infancy, manhood, teaching, character, preaching, reception, rejection, death, burial, resurrection, and ascension were all prewritten in the most marvelous manner centuries before He was born."

No such claim can be made or substantiated of any other founder of a religion .Jesus said of himself, I am the alpha and Omega, the first and the last, the Beginning and the End (Revelation 22:13). As Herbert Lockyer wrote in his book, "All the Promises of the Bible, "Christ gives value to the Bible, not the Bible to Christ. Christ is the secret of the structural, historical, prophetical, doctrinal and spiritual aspects of the Bible."

Prophecies from Micah and Hosea were written 700 years before Christ's Birth. Six hundred years before his birth Isaiah spoke of His coming. When he was born angels announced his birth to lowly shepherds on the hillside watching their sheep at night.
