A WORD FROM OUR PASTOR

What are the words I live by? Well, if you were standing in my kitchen you would see a "sign" on the wall over the stove that reads

I am enough I have enough God is enough

They serve as reminders of what I can base all of life upon. But let me ask you---can you say those words honestly? I don't know about you but the one I am acutely aware that I struggle with the most is the first one---I am enough. My years of training to be a Spiritual Director taught me that the number one obstacle to a full and healthy relationship with God is self-rejection. We are bombarded it seems almost from birth with messages that say you are not smart/pretty/successful, athletic, wealthy (fill in the blank) enough and it becomes not only our self image but often the way we think God views us as well.

May I gently remind you of the cross that Jesus died upon. If it is real, and I have bet my life on it, then think of what it means. It demonstrates for all times and all persons that we are loved so much that God would send his Son who then willingly died for each of us. In other words, you and I MATTER. Look in the mirror today and consider that someone died for you. YOU ARE ENOUGH so don't let the cross and its message be discounted.

So what words are the north star for my life----the word "enough" is so hard to trust. But that is the word for you today, I pray. All those other messages---those aren't God's voice, they are the world's voice, and only through prayer and trust and divine vision will your truest identity llve in you. It takes courage. But they are the only words that are true.
