Giving To Help Others

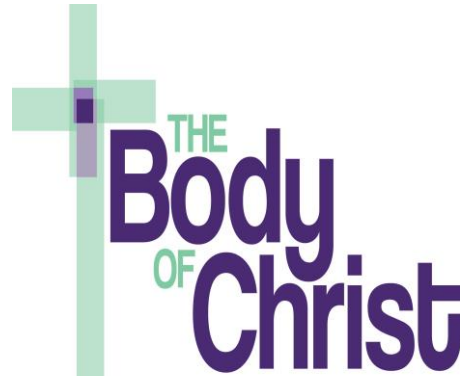
Next Sunday, September 29 is our 5th Sunday Benevolence Offering. Please come prepared to give to this collection, mark your check and/or envelope Benevolent.
