


A WORD FROM OUR PASTOR

This Sunday is a special day as we set aside Lib Gordon to the ministry of deacon. This is a critical position of ministry that stands alongside the pastor in ministering to the church family. I recall the words a pastor friend of mine wrote about one of his deacons, Frank Covey.

Others of you serve your Master by serving "his brethren." May God raise up more Frank and Helen Coveys in our midst."
