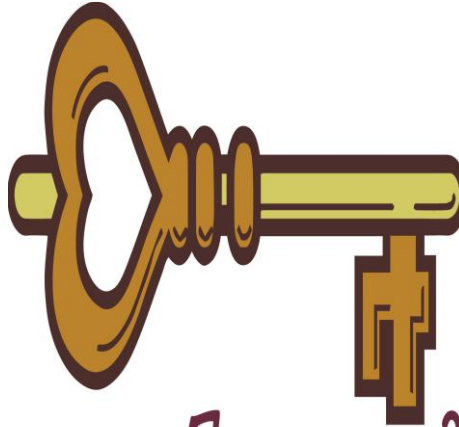


Sunday, May 18
