


The church office will be closed the week of July 4th.

A WORD FROM OUR PASTOR

"...his sheep follow Him because they know His voice" (John 10) A question I often ask others and ask myself---"What voice are you listening to?"

There are so many voices competing for our attention nearly every day. Which voice sounds loudest to you these days? The voice of God or the voice of the world? The voice of the morning paper

or evening news or the voice of Scripture? The voice of your spouse/best friend/boss or the voice of the Good Shepherd? The voice of peace or the voice of war? The voice that says you are not enough or the voice of unconditional acceptance? So many voices competing to gain attention and control your life?

When those voices become too much may I suggest you be still and trust the voice of love that is the voice of God and the only voice that ultimately is truth and dependable.
