

### **Business Meeting Update**

- Approved reduced rent for Christ Connect church. Christ Connect has asked for a reduction in the amount of rent they pay through the end of the year. The RBA has offered to help offset that reduction.
- Approved suspension of special offerings for Pantry and Benevolent fund until they get down to \$1000 or less.
- Approved the Technology committee request to train and pay Kimora (youth) for working in sound booth. This will add \$600 to the Tech budget for 2025.
- Beth reported that the cafe raised \$1,565,00 for roof fund.


