A WORD FROM OUR PASTOR

This coming Sunday I begin a series related to the Bible---its value, how to read it, the authority of Scripture, etc.

Here's some habits to add to your life:

- Choose a regular time to spend time in God's word
- Start with one book---in the New Testament, one of the Gospels; in the Old Testament, the Psalms or Isaiah
- Pray before reading
- If one verse seems to uniquely stick with you, ponder why that is. Don't rush through
- Share what you learn. Discussing Scripture with family or friends opens up new insights and deepens relationships.

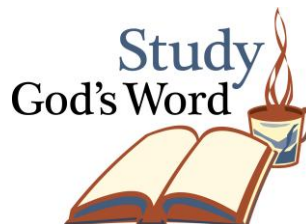
